



Psalm 110

Psalm 110 is called "The Royal Psalm." It's a messianic psalm—one that in some way refers to the Messiah. Different from all other messianic psalms, this one does not have primary application to any Jewish king. It applies exclusively to the Messiah, the Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus, in fact, applies it to Himself on three occasions.

Message:

David prophesies that Jesus Christ, the eternal priest-king, will remain seated at God's right hand in heaven until He destroys His enemies at His Second Coming. Then He will begin His millennial reign on earth.

David Yahweh	Yahweh has taken an oath and He will not be sorry. "You (are) a priest forever in the manner of Melchizedek!"	Eternity Past
David	The Lord at your right hand will severely wound the kings in the day of His anger. He will judge among the nations, He will fill (them) with dead bodies. He will severely wound the head over much land. From the stream by the way He will drink. Upon ground of such conditions He will lift up (His) head.	Second Advent Millennium
